Laura Clark explained the grant she wrote for the Crotched Mountain Foundation. The Crotched Mountain Foundation has awarded Lisbon Regional \$50,000 to analyze special ed programming and develop ways to grow inclusionary practices. The school intends to use this grant to pay for training, evidence-based intervention, special education evaluation, as well as whole-school evaluation. Partners from the grant toured the school last week and expressed Lisbon will be eligible next year for an even larger grant as the foundation would like to see Lisbon evolve over multiple years. Superintendent Tari Thomas expressed that appreciation and recognition go to the Crotched Mountain Foundation for supporting our growth in meeting the needs of all learners as well as Lisbon Regional's Laura Clark for writing the grant and leading this important initiative.
