

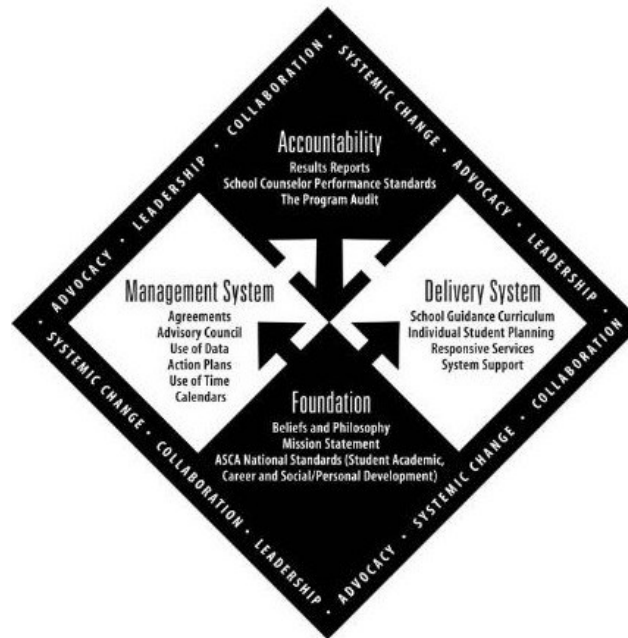
“School counseling programs provide education, prevention and intervention services, which are integrated into all aspects of children’s lives.
